- **Potential Hosts:** Please proceed to the [Become a Host Home](#) and apply to be a host home. The process is simple and free. You can share what information you're comfortable with online and potential guests can ask for further details when they reach out to you.
- **Potential Guests:** Please type a location you're traveling to into the search box and peruse the nearby options for Host Homes. Find the host's contact information on their site and connect with them to discuss dates, amenities, pets, meals, and other appropriate details. Hosts have an application for you and may have house rules.
